

OFFICIAL LUMBERJACK CAR SHOW RULES

In an effort to keep things simple and to be as inclusive as possible, we've established the following rules and categories for the ACC Lumberjack Car Show:

- 1. Cars and trucks will compete equally in the categories listed.
- 2. Results of judging will be final and will be decided by both a panel and by popular choice.
- 3. There will be one (1) winner per category, no second place or below.
- 4. We will start parking cars at 8:30 and ask that all entries be in place by 9:30.
- 5. Due to an expected high volume of pedestrian traffic, cars should remain parked until the end of the show at 4:00 p.m.
- 6. Award ceremony will be at 3 p.m.
- 7. There will be no exhibitionist driving, i.e. hole-shots, burn-outs, donuts, allowed.
- 8. This is a fun, family event so there is no alcohol allowed on college grounds.
- 9. Anyone acting in a disorderly manner will be asked to leave.
- 10. Anyone not having fun will be held down and tickled until they giggle!

ALPENA CATEGORIES DEFINED **COMMUNITY COLLEGE HURON SHORES**

A through E should be self-explanatory and will include a stock and custom class. Please mark the appropriate era and class on your entry.

- 1. American Muscle: The true era of the American Muscle Car runs from the mid 60's until about the mid 70's and is characterized by large displacement engines, horsepower, torque and intimidation. If your car is a fuel burning, fire breathing, tire burning torque monster, this is your class.
- 2. **Tuners:** If you've added things like nitrous or a turbo and added a "fart can" muffler to your stock car to make it go faster, and a whale tail and ground effects to hold it to the ground, this is you!
- 3. Military Vehicles: Since we're located on an old military base is appropriate that we have a class for ex or even current military vehicles. If you have a jeep, deuce, APC, Sherman or Abrahms, Patriot, launcher......vou get the point, bring it! (no live ammo please)
- 4. Campaign Cars Track and Strip Racers: This class is for any vehicle who's primary use is racing. This includes but is not limited to, oval track, drag strip, road course, sand dunes and baja.
- 5. "Who Died In That Wreck" Has anyone ever asked you, "who died in that wreck?" Is your car barely clinging to life, rusted to pieces, pigeon-toed, incontinent and smoking like a brush fire? Do people laugh when they pass you? Do parts regularly fall off? Are the tires and brakes marginal? If you answered yes to any or all questions this is your category. We're looking for the worst drivable car in the neighborhood. You must drive it in, and, bring your own oil diaper! Licensed cars only, please.
- 6. **Defibrillator Bass:** If your stereo bass sends out a soundwave that will start a stopped heart, this is your category. We're after bass that can be felt for a quarter of a mile.
- 7. **Non-Motorized**: This could be vintage campers or trailers, bicycles, wagons, or... convince us! Please ask for approval before entering
- 8. Non-motorized 12 and under: Ok, kids, do you have a custom bicycle, scooter, pedal car, or wagon? You must be 12 or under and must have done most of the customizing yourself.
- 9. **Motorized 16 and under:** We are looking for motorcycles, golf carts, go carts, and yes, even first cars. You must be 16 or under, have done your own work/customizing, and must not drive it here if you (or it) are not legal.
- 10. **High School Cool:** If you are still in high school and your baby is a custom work in progress, this is for you. We are looking for nice High School Rides.
- 11. Rat Rods: Your traditional junkyard hot rod built from used, repurposed or donated parts, with faded paint and aged patina.
- 12. **Best Paint:** This category will be judged on paint quality and attention to detail. You will not have to enter this category. All cars the judges deem worthy of this award will be judged automatically.
- 13. **Best Graphic**: This category includes airbrushed graphics and murals, pin striping, wraps and stickers. All cars the judges deem worthy of this award will be judged automatically.
- 14. **Judges Choice:** The best car at the show by the judges consensus.
- 15. **Popular Choice**: The best car at the show by spectator vote.
- 16. Kids' Choice Award: Presented by Summit Racing Equipment, this award is based on votes from kids 18 and under by "official" kid judges.

I expressly waive any defense to enforcement of this Agreement arising from any claim of lack of consideration and understand that this Agreement constitutes a legal, valid and binding waiver of my rights and shall be enforceable against me, my spouse, family, heirs, assigns, personal representatives and estate for all purposes.

I understand that my automobile(s) and I may be photographed or filmed during the event and agree to allow Alpena Community College the use of any photograph, video imagine or film likeness of me or my automobile(s)/motorcycle(s)for any legitimate purpose, including without limitation publication and program inclusion now and in the future, without financial compensation to me.
