If you are applying for an academic scholarship or other types of general scholarships (as listed in the college catalog), you must file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid and an ACC Scholarship Application Form, available at area high schools and from the Financial Aid Office, Alpena Community College. Both forms are available beginning in late January for the following academic year.
