Spring 2019 Graduation Application deadline is Friday, February 1. Graduation applications are available in the Registrar's Office in Alpena, the ACC Oscoda Office, or on WebAdvisor.

Early Registration for Returning Students began Monday, October 29 and goes through December 7. Tuition is due **December 7**. The Spring 2019 schedule of classes is now available for viewing through WebAdvisor.

Costa Rica/Summer 2019 – BIO 129 Field Biology (no prerequisites) or BIO 215 Field Botany (has prerequisites) – class size limited to 15. Class begins Tuesday, May 21, 5-7pm. Costa Rica Trip is June 13-27. Register for class and pay tuition March 25-May 13 prior to the beginning of the class. **Estimated** cost is \$3,800 plus tuition for 3 credit/4 contact hour class. The deadline for minimum payments for registration is January 18, 2019, to reserve a seat in class and buy a plane ticket (non-refundable). Other payments are due 2/15/19 - \$700; 3/15/19 - \$800; 4/19/19 - \$800; 5/10/19 - \$500 or remainder. There is an ACC Foundation Scholarship available for students for a portion of the cost.
