Welcome to Fall 2020 Semester, Lumberjacks

Course Withdrawal Deadlines: Individual Course Withdrawal (W Grade) is Friday, November 6. Complete Withdrawal (all courses W Grades) is Friday, December 11. For short courses (less than 16 weeks), please contact the Registrar's Office for drop/withdrawal dates.

Spring 2021 Early Registration for returning students begins Monday, October 26. Tuition is due by December 11.

Fall Graduation Applications – The deadline to turn in Fall Graduation Applications was Friday, October 9. Please turn in your application as soon as possible. Graduation applications are available in the Registrar's Office or on WebAdvisor.

Prospective Nursing Students it is time to submit your nursing program application for the Spring 2021 LPN and RN Nursing Programs. You are eligible to apply if you are currently enrolled in your last semester of prerequisite courses. Application information is available on the program website. **Submission deadline is November 10, 2020.**

Fall 2020 Semester Student Account Balance Checks will be available for pick-up from the cashier between 9am-2pm on the following date.

Checks may be picked up ONLY by student whose name is on the check. You must have a picture ID. All checks not picked up by 2pm on these dates will be mailed.

In preparation, brief training and rehearsal calls must be completed before the Election. Masks, gloves, disinfecting wipes and hand sanitizer are provided for Election Day. Exit Pollsters must be responsible, punctual and polite, with own transportation. Workers will be paid promptly after returned materials are processed.
