2018 ACC HONORS BREAKFAST RESULTS

The annual Alpena Community College **Honors Breakfast** was held at 9 a.m. today at the APlex. The event recognized students who maintain a grade point average of 3.5 or better. Phi Theta Kappa, the community college honor society, Sigma Zeta, the math and science honor society, the Student Ambassadors, and the Student Leaders groups also recognized academically talented students. This is the fifth year the Outstanding Student Awards have been presented at the Honors Breakfast. Veterans receive a special stole to signify their veteran status and are given another special stole if they are an honor graduate.

This year 154 graduates and candidates were invited to participate; 82 attended the event.

The **John M. Grant Front Runner Awards** were also presented at the Honors Breakfast. This award is given annually to a graduating male and female non-traditional student who has demonstrated unusual dedication in the pursuit of higher education.
